Senator Fasano and Representative Fontana Help Secure Funding for North Haven

State Senator Len Fasano (R-34th) and State Representative Steve Fontana (D-87th) are happy to announce that the Town of North Haven has been awarded a \$30,000 grant to assist with a traffic study between Route 17 and Montowese Avenue in North Haven. The funding was awarded through the Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP).

“The traffic around this area has become increasingly tight and dangerous for North Haven residence,” explained Senator Fasano, who thanked both Representative Fontana and Governor M. Jodi Rell for their assistance in securing this funding. “This study will help analyze area traffic patterns so we can find out the best possible solution to make travel quicker and safer for those traveling in and around the Montowese Avenue area.”

“I am pleased to work with Sen. Fasano to secure these funds for the town of North Haven. These funds will help determine what we need to do to improve traffic flow in and around Montowese Avenue,” said Rep. Fontana.

STEAP, a program run through the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development's Office of Municipal Development, funds economic development, community conservation and quality of life projects for towns that are ineligible to receive Urban Act funding.

Senator Fasano represents the 34th District Communities of North Haven, East Haven, and Wallingford.
