REP. FONTANA ANNOUNCES NORTH HAVEN TO RECEIVE \$182,510 FOR ROADS

State Representative **Steve Fontana** (D-North Haven) announced today that North Haven soon will receive \$182,510 from the state in Town Aid Road (TAR) funds to pay for improvements to North Haven's roads and infrastructure.

The funds were approved at the State Bond Commission's meeting today, and the money is expected to be delivered to North Haven within 2-4 weeks.

"Every winter, our roads in town take a beating, and our TAR grant will help to pay for repairing them and keeping our property taxes down. I'm thankful that the governor finally released this money," said Representative Fontana.

In January, Representative Fontana joined other lawmakers in calling on the governor to release these funds, which are normally released in January and July of each year but were held back by Governor Rell this year.

"I know that there are streets and road all over North Haven that need attention, and this grant will help the town to pay for repaving them," said Representative Fontana.
